The Company will collect the personal details that you provide to us on our website for the purposes of providing you with Services and/or information. In providing such Services and/or information to you we will only use your personal data in accordance with the terms of the following statement.

This statement sets out below:

Information Collection and Use

Job Seeker Registration

We request information from you on our online profile registration form. Here you must provide contact information and upload a CV to be able to subsequently apply for jobs with Employers advertising on our site. In addition, this information along with your job search criteria is used to enable you to receive email job alerts as you require. Your contact details and uploaded CV will be sent directly to the advertising Employer when you submit a Vacancy application via our Site. The Employer with whom you have applied for a Vacancy, will use your provided contact information to make contact with you. The Company does not use this information for any other purpose.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.
